Who do we work with?

Young People under 19 years of age, up to 25 years for vulnerable groups of young people. Youth workers and services for young people.

Young people that want to be heard by the people who make decisions.

Youth services that want a skilled, trained and capable workforce.

Practitioners that want to learn and work in partnership.

What are the consequences if our work doesn't happen?

Young people become disengaged. The youth workforce is less prepared and there is a lack of opportunities to work in partnership within the youth sector.
